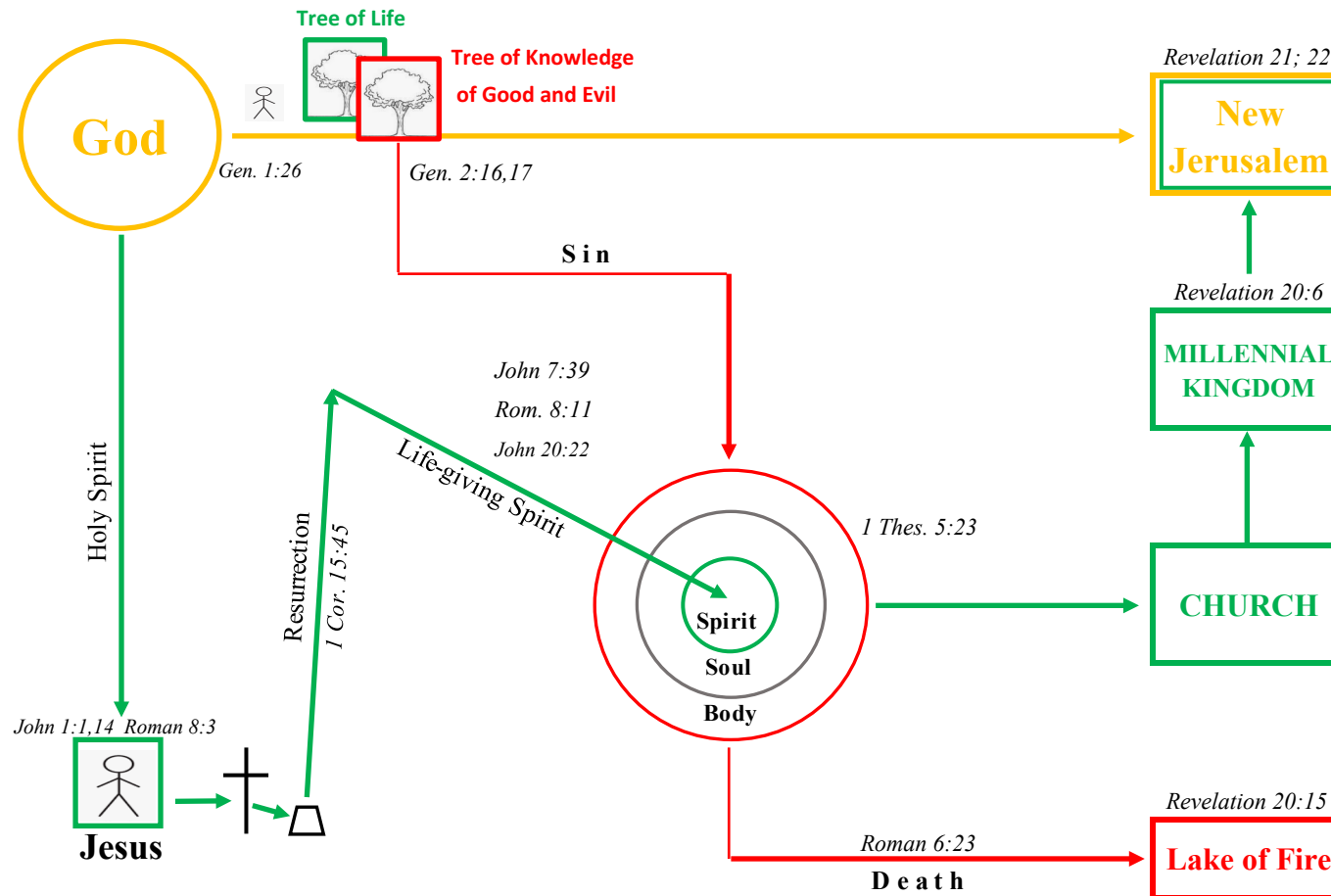


THE CHURCH IN REGINA - The Mystery of Human Life

Genesis 1:26

"Blessed and holy is he who has part in the **first resurrection**; over these the second death has no authority, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a **thousand years**."

God's Plan God desires to express Himself through man (Romans 8:29). For this purpose, He created man in His own **image** (Genesis 1:26).

Just as a glove is made in the image of a hand to contain a hand, so also man is made in the image of God to contain God. By receiving God as his content, man can express God (2 Corinthians 4:7).

Man To fulfill His plan, God made a man as a **vessel** (Romans 9:21-24). This vessel has three parts: body, soul, and spirit (1 Thes. 5:23).

The human spirit, the innermost part of man, was made to contact and receive God Himself (John 4:24). Man was created not merely to contain food in his stomach, or to contain knowledge in his mind, but to **contain God in his spirit** (Ephesians 5:18).
